On October 14, 2010, Landec Corporation (the “Company”) held its Annual Meeting of Stockholders. The two proposals presented to stockholders were the election of four Class 1 directors and the ratification of the appointment of Ernst & Young LLP as the Company’s independent registered public accounting firm for the fiscal year ending May 29, 2011.

The voting results for the election of directors were as follows:

All of the nominees were elected.

The ratification of the appointment of Ernst & Young LLP as the Company’s independent registered public accounting firm for the fiscal year ending May 29, 2011 received 22,011,301 votes for approval and 1,496,202 votes against approval, with 16,334 votes abstaining.
